
GENERAL PROJECT OVERVIEW: PURPOSE AND NEED

Traffic Calming Master Plan Phase 1







TRAFFIC CALMING DEVICE RECOMMENDATIONS

Installation of speed tables, at their respective centerlines, along Arthur St. from S.R. 7 to N. 56th Ave is proposed as follows:

- New speed table #1: west of N. 56th Ave.
- New speed table #2: west of N. 57th Ave.
- New speed table #3: west of N. 58th Terr.
- New speed table #4: west of N. 59th Ave.





TRAFFIC CALMING DEVICE RECOMMENDATIONS

The installation of speed tables, at their respective centerlines, along N. 58th Ave. from Taft St. to Sheridan St. is proposed as follows:

- New speed table #1 south of Liberty St.
- New speed table #2 south of W. Park Rd.
- New speed table #3 south of Mosely St.
- New speed table #4 south of Arthur St.






TRAFFIC CALMING DEVICE RECOMMENDATIONS

The installation of speed tables, at their respective centerlines, along N. Park Road from Sheridan St. to Stirling Rd. is proposed as follows:

- Intersection modifications at the Atlanta Ave./TY Park entrance intersection.
- Intersection modifications at the Emerald Oaks Dr. intersection
- Install a modified chicane centered on the N 34th St. T-intersection.
- Install a second chicane centered on N. Hills Dr.
- Install four Electronic Speed Feedback signs at these two locations:
 - South of Farragut St. centerline in the south median of the intersection
 - > South of N. 34th Ave. centerline on the right side of the road
 - South of N. 37th Ave.
 - North of Oak St. centerline on the northwest corner of the intersection





TRAFFIC CALMING DEVICE RECOMMENDATIONS

The installation of speed tables, at their respective centerlines, along Thomas St. from State Rd. 7 to N. 56th Ave. is proposed as follows:

- New speed table #1 50 feet east of N. 59th Terr.
- New speed table #2 100 feet west of N. 58th Terr.
- New speed table #3 60 feet west of N. 57th Terr.
- New speed table #4 125 feet west of N. 56th Terr.
